Regular Departmental Action against Shri Jankar Nath, the then Executive Engineer, City Drainage Civil Division, Srinagar Municipal Corporation (Verification No. SLK-04/2016) - dropping of charges thereof.

- 1. Whereas, Housing & Urban Development Department vide OM dated 11.06.2024, has forwarded a copy of thecommunication No. GAD/VIG0RDA/5/2023-02-GAD (CC No. 7100606) dated 03.06.2024 of General Administration Department and requested to share the action taken in the matter with the General Administration Department and Anti Corruption Bureau; and
- 2. Whereas, Anti Corruption Bureau while forwarding letter dated 15.04.2024 to GAD has intimated that subject verification was concluded with the recommendation for initiation of Regular Departmental Action against Shri Jankar Nath, the then Executive Engineer; and
- 3. Whereas, Anti Corruption Bureau, J&K vide letter dated 08.12.2022 has intimated that the verification was conducted by the Bureau on the basis of complaint lodged by Adil Bashir, President Valley Construction Contractors Union, Nawa bazar Srinagar against the officers/officials of City Drainage Civil Division SMC Kaka Sarie, Srinagar alleging therein the allegations of embezzlement and violations in the works at Rajbagh and Chanpora, etc.; and
- 4. Whereas, the details of the works executed by the charged officer alongwith date of allotment are as under:-

- 5. Whereas, Anti-Corruption Bureau, J&K in its letter dated 08.12.2022 at point-3 has intimated that as per probe conducted, the works were executed departmentally except extension approved of Rs.3.06 lakh against basic allotment of Rs.16.60 lakhs in respect of works S. No. 3 and also in respect of work at S. No. 4 which was initially advertised as short-term tender notice, gross violation in codal procedures has been observed in according approvals/extensions on the rate structure of SSR 2012, however no loss to the exchequer has been caused. But the officers of department have violated the codal procedures. The main portion of works were tendered and only subsequent works in lanes/by-lanes have been taken in hand departmentally in the interest of public and Govt. work and on the instructions of senior officers at per spot position and circumstances; and
- 6. Whereas, Anti Corruption Bureau has observed as under:
 - i. No double drawl of funds has taken place as well as the main portion of work was put to tender, however subsequently some works were executed departmentally on approval basis due to exigency to give immediate relief to locals of the area.
 - ii. The works are found to be executed as per measurement, as such, no loss has been caused to Govt. Exchequer. However, the officers of department have violated the codal procedures.
 - iii. The justification tendered to go for execution of remaining portion departmentally/on approval basis based on the spot situation and circumstances are justifiable to some extent.
 - iv. Two amongst the three public servants stand retired from active service now except one Jhankar Nath, then Executive Engineer who is still in active services and responsible for departmental action.
- 7. Whereas, Anti Corruption Bureau, recommended that Regular Department Action may be initiated against Shri Jankar Nath S/o Haru Ram R/o Ghari Bishnah, then Executive Engineer, SMC for violation of Codal Procedures; and
- 8. Whereas, the charged officer namely Shri Jankar Nath, the then Executive Engineer stand retired from the Government Service on superannuation on 31.05.2024; and
- 9. Whereas, Article 168-A of the J&K CSR governs departmental proceedings against retired officials prescribing therein that loss caused to the government during his service may be recovered from the pension of an officer found in Judicial or Departmental proceedings by the negligence or fraud of such officer; and
- 10. Whereas, in the instant case, taking note that there was no financial loss, the case file was referred to the General Administration Department for clarification it has opined, vide U.O. No. GAD-VIG0RDA/5/2023-09-GAD (CC: 710066) dated 11.10.2024 as under: -

Returned:- RDA can be initiated against a retired public servant within one year of his/her retirement in terms of Article 168-A of J&K CSRs, however, the same is meant for recovery of loss(es), if any, caused to the Government exchequer due to the public servant while in-service. The Department is, accordingly, advised to take further necessary action in the matter.

- 11. Whereas, taking note of the above, the case details have been placed before the Competent Authority (Hon'ble Minister for Jal Shakti Department) who has approved the dropping of the charges.
- 12. Now, therefore, the charges leveled against Shri Jankar Nath S/o Sh. Haru Ram R/o Ghari Bishnah, the then Executive Engineer & Superintending Engineer, City Drainage Civil Division, Srinagar Municipal Corporation (now retired) in verification No. SLK-04/2016 are hereby dropped in the instant case and the case is closed at the departmental level.
